



<u>Minutes from Congregational Meeting, April 14, 2019:</u> Motion to approve minutes, Sherry, Second, Troy – Approved. Meeting called to order by President Bill Lewis at 9:58 AM. After presentation and explanation by Harris Haugen representing property and management committee, President Lewis called for a motion on 2 questions:

- 2. Motion to approve asphalt paving of parking lot from concrete work south to the grass area. M/S Mel Kirchhoff/Dean Schutte. Motion approved, Ayes 74, Nays 1.




